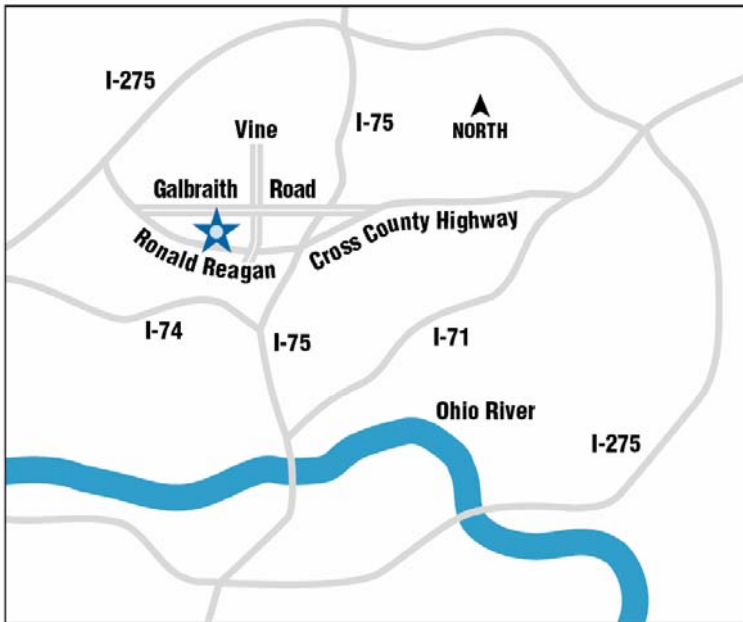

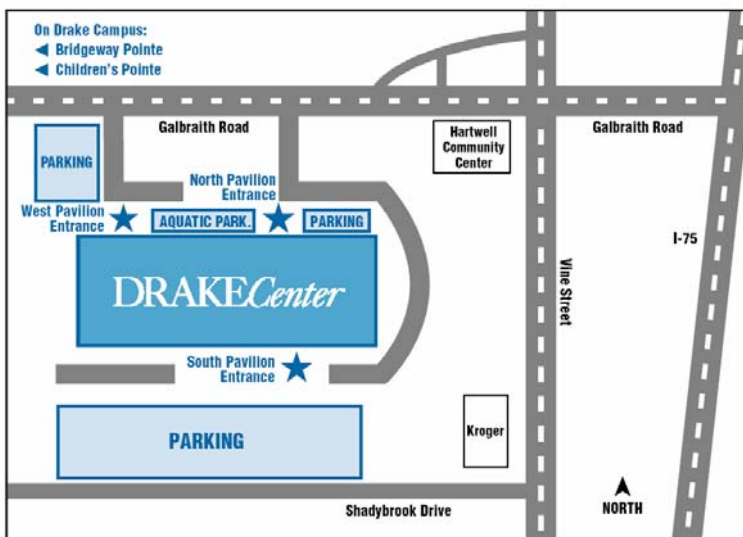


Getting to Drake Center
