

## Football Game Day Party Food

### Ultimate 7-Layer Dip

1 Can (16 oz) Taco Bell Home Originals refried beans  
1 tbsp. Taco Bell Home Originals Taco Seasoning Mix  
1 cup Breakstone's or Knudsen Sour Cream  
1 cup Taco Bell Home Originals Thick 'N Chunky Salsa  
1 cup shredded lettuce  
1 cup Kraft shredded Mexican Style Shredded Cheese  
½ cup sliced green onions  
2 Tbsp. sliced pitted ripe olives  
Ritz Chips Original or Wheat Thins Baked Snack Crackers

Mix beans and taco seasoning mix, Spread onto bottom of 9 inch pie plate or quiche dish.

Layer all remaining ingredients except chips over bean mixture.  
Cover. Refrigerate several hour or until chilled.

Serve with chips.

Makes 48 servings: 2 Tbsp dip and 14 chips each.

### Football Cake

1 pkg. (2 layer size) chocolate cake mix  
1 1/3 cups brewed double strength Maxwell House Coffee Chilled  
3 Cups Cappuccino Pudding Frosting

Prepare cake batter and bake in greased and floured 13x 9 baking pan as directed on package, substituting coffee for the water. Cool 15 min; remove from pan to wire rack. Cool completely.

Trim corners and sides from cake to resemble football shape. Reserve trimmings for snaking or another use.

Frost with Cappuccino Pudding Frosting. Store in refrigerator. Makes 15 servings.

### Cappuccino Pudding Frosting

½ Cup Chilled Brewed Strong Maxwell Coffee

½ Cup cold milk

1 pkg (4 serving size) jell-o brand Vanilla Flavor instant pudding and pie filling  
1 tub c

Cool whip whipped topping (8 Oz)

Pour coffee and milk into medium bowl. Add dry pudding mix and beat with wire whisk minutes.

Gently stir in whipped topping.

Spread into a cooled cake or cupcakes
